 - It's an integrated subject which imparts knowledge skills and attitudes from different disciplines in order to enable individuals lead a quality life.
- 2. Give any 2 measures which prevent the occurrence of athlete's foot (2mks)
 - Keep feet dry especially between the toes
 - Avoid wearing wet shoes and socks
 - Avoid sharing shoes and socks
- 3. Identify 2 major causes of suffocation (2mks)
 - Inhalation of fumes or poisonous gases
 - Placing polythene bags over the head
 - Physical barriers to the airway which causes obstruction

SECTION B 20MKS (COMPULSORY QUESTIONS)

- 21. Your aunt has come to visit over the holiday. Describe how you would do the following for her.
 - a) Launder her loose colored cotton lesso (10mks)
 - Shake the article to remove loose dirt
 - Wash in warm soapy water
 - Wash quickly in water using kneading and squeezing
 - Rinse in warm water until all traces of soap are removed
 - Finally rinse in cold water into which salt has been added
 - Dry under the shade on the WS
 - Iron while still damp using a moderately hot iron on the WS
 - Air the lesso
 - Fold and store appropriately
 - b) Make the bed that she is going to use (10mks)
 - Strip the bed and place the bedding on a chair

- Dust the bedstead and turn the mattress
- put the under blanket right side up
- put the under sheet, right side up with the wider hem to the head side. The linen must be centrally placed
- tuck both the blanket and sheet firmly and mitre the corners
- put the top sheet right side down, the wider hem at the head side and reaching just beyond the head of the mattress
- put the top blankets separately, right side up to reach just short of the top sheet
- tuck the mitre at the bottom ends of both blankets and sheets
- turn down the sheet over the blankets and tuck the sides
- put the pillow cases and place pillow in position
- put the bedspread

SECTION C 40 MKS (CHOOSE ANY 2 QUESTIONS)

- 22 a) Explain any 4 practices necessary for maintaining healthy teeth (8mks)
 - Brush the teeth (oral hygiene) after every meal in order to freshen the teeth
 - Floss the teeth once in a while to clean in between the teeth to prevent tooth decaying/cavities
 - Rinse the once in a while with antibacterial mouth wash to help kill germs
 - Visit the dentist regularly for checkups
 - Exercise jaw & strengthen the teeth by eating hard foods
 - Eat a balanced diet rich in calcium, phosphorous, fluorine, vitamins A, D&C for healthy and strong teeth
 - b) Discuss 4 qualities of a well-made in seam pocket. (8mks)
 - Seam allowance should be trimmed and well neatened
 - Should be well placed at a strategic place in the seam for convenience during use
 - Pocket should be well pressed and laying flat towards the front of the garment
 - Pocket bag should be deep enough
 - Pocket bag should be joined with appropriate stitches for strength
 - It should be well reinforced on the upper and edges of the pocket mouth on the RS of the garment
 - c) Highlight 4 importance of consumer education (4mks)
 - Informs consumers on the importance of planning for the family finances
 - Enables the consumer to budget and spend family resources wisely and economically
 - Informs people on their rights as consumers so as to not be exploited
 - Helps people understand their role as consumers and their importance to manufacturers of service providers
 - It enables one to interpreted and use advertisement wisely and to their own advantage
- 23 a) Explain how the following factors contribute to successful meal planning (8mks)
 - Nutritional balance
 - A well balanced diet with all the nutrients provided in the required right amounts and proportion will ensure successful meal planning hence meeting all the nutrient needs
 - ii. Climate

- A meal providing more of hot foods during cold weather and more of cold foods during the hot
 weather, will successfully meet the climate needs of people taking the meal
- iii. Texture
- Providing variety of food textures e.g. crispy, crunchy and tender in a meal will ensure meeting the variety need of texture in a meal
- iv. Food in season
- Providing foods in a season such as fruits and vegetables, they are usually more available and cheaper and fresh hence meeting successful meal planning
- b) Discuss 4 points to consider when selecting fastenings (8mks)
 - Type of garment: zip fasteners are suitable for skirts and trousers while buttons are appropriate on shirts and blouses
 - Position of the opening: buttons and buttonholes are appropriate for front openings of shirts and blouses, while zips fastenings are suitable at the back openings of skirts
 - Effect desired: if a decorative effect is desired, decorative buttons can be used and zips can be used inconspicuously
 - Age of the wearer: nonmetallic fasteners, Velcro tapes and press studs are suitable for baby clothes
 - Size of the opening: the fasteners should be proportional to the opening
 - Color of the garment: fasteners chosen should be the same color as the garment unless decorative
 - Type of fabric: heavy fabrics require large and strong fasteners such as buttons and buttonholes while for frying fabrics use buttons & Rouleau loops
- c) Identify any 4 factors that affect the efficiency of a detergent (4mks)
 - Types of builders present
 - Washing time
 - Type of water used
 - Temperature of the water
 - Mechanical action
- 24 a) Explain any 4 processes to be carried out on a fabric before laying out patterns (8mks)
 - Press to remove creases to ensure accurate measurements
 - Check the grain when the fabric is folded with the selvedges together to ensure that the wefts edges lies flat and even
 - Pull the fabric in the opposite direction of the off grain slant to grain
 - Pull a thread across the fabric in order to ensure that the edge is on a straight grain
 - Check for faults on the fabric to avoid the same on the garment
- b) Explain any 4 factors that may affect normal foetal development(8mks)
 - Sexually transmitted infections e.g. gonorrhea and syphilis. Gonorrhea can be cause blindness to the child
 - Alcohol and smoking can cause the baby to underweight during birth
 - HIV/Aids may cause the baby to suffer full blown aids and die before the 5th birthday
 - Drugs may cause the bay to be underweight and even prescribed medicines can lead to miscarriage
 - Trauma and any unpleasant experiences that cause distress and anxiety may lead to miscarriage
 - German measles may deform the baby if it occurs during the first three months of pregnancy
 - Nutrient deficiency may cause the baby to be mentally and physically retarded



c) State any 4 advantages of using firewood as a fuel for cooking (4mks)

- Readily available in rural areas
- It is less costly
- It's easy to use
- Helps heat the house besides other uses
- Aromatic woods are used for curing milk gourds and flavoring sour milk
- It provides abrasives e.g. ash for washing utensils and disinfecting latrines and chicken houses
