 - When Simon saw this he questioned Jesus power if he were a prophet he would have noticed that the woman was a sinner
 - And Jesus answered him by telling him about a certain creditor who had to debtors, one owned him a 100 denarii and the other 50
 - When asked Simon which of the debtors would love the creditor more Simon said the one who
 was forgiven more
 - Jesus said you have judged rightly since he had not given him even water to wash his feet.
 - But the woman used her tears to wet Jesus feet and wept them using her hair and oiled them. Therefore her sinned which are many RE Forgiven for she loved much.
