- **Irony**: Seymour says that they would be better armed to deal with the trouble yet this would get them into trouble. ✓ This develops the theme of poor leadership/bad governance. This also portrays Seymour as selfish/corrupt/calculating ✓
- **Idiom**: Over my dead body. ✓ This shows Mossi's determination not to reallocate budget line items/get money from the Municipal Fund ✓
- **Simile**: and can strike harder than thunder. ✓ Brings out the intensity of the action ✓
- **Hyperbole**: I can make you see real smoke ✓ Brings out the intensity of the action ✓ *Identification plus illustration*, *I mark*; *effect 1 mark*

  Tense√/suspenseful/apprehensive/fearful: over my dead body√/...get us deeper into problems/don't start pontificating/I can make you see real smoke
