- v) Conferences/seminars/courses attended – name the conference/seminar or course, town, date, role you played 2mks
- vi) Hobbies or interests – especially the ones related to teaching 4mks
- vii) References, include at last three references, including academics and professionals
 - These should be people you know but not your relatives
 - Include designation, address and telephone numbers 3mks

- Content – relevance and organization 8mks
- Grammar – accuracy and variety of structures 8mks
- Spelling and punctuations 4mks
