16.Outline events that took place from the time Jesus was arrested to His death on the cross.

(10 marks)

- Jesus was taken to the chief priest after His arrest.
- He was mocked, ridiculed, blindfolded, struck and asked to prophesy the person who had struck him three times.
- In the morning He was taken before the Sanhedrin for trial.
- The Sanhedrin referred Him to Pilate who found no crime deserving death for Him. \geq
- Pilate referred Him to Herod for further trial. Herod dressed Him in Kingly robe and referred Him back to Pilate the second time.
- Pilate found no crime deserving death and handed Jesus to the crowd for crucifixion.
- The journey to the skull began and women wept as Jesus was led for crucifixion. \geq
- At the skull, Jesus was crucified between two thieves.
- He commended His spirit to God and breathed His last or died. \geq

After His death, extra ordinary things happened such as darkness from the sixth hour to the ninth hour, the curtain of the temple was torn into two and the Centurion confessed that Jesus was innocent.
