Plastic table

- Collect all the equipments and materials required wash in hot soapy water to remove fixed dirt using a soft cloth or sponge to prevent scratching.
- Rinse thoroughly in hot water to remove traces of soap.
- Dry completely and rub or buff with a soft cloth to shine.
- Store appropriately.
- b) Outline the steps to follow when laundering your brother's a crylic socks. (9mks) Acrylic socks
 - Collect all the equipments and materials required.



- Soak in cold water for a short time.
- Wash in warm soapy water using kneading and squeezing method.
- Rinse thoroughly in warm water
- Final rinse in cold water to freshen
- Add fabric conditioner in the final rinsing waters.
- Drip dry under shape and secure with pegs by the toes.
- Press using a warm iron
- Air to dry completely.
- Store appropriately.

c) Outline the procedure to follow when cleaning a plain wooden chopping board that you will use.

- Collect all the equipment and materials required.
- Clean with warm soapy water and a scouring pad to scrub the surface.
- Rinse thoroughly in warm water.
- Final rinse in cold water
- Wipe with a dry cloth
- Leave in a warm dirty place to dry completely.
